FATALITY: East London campus

It is with a heavy heart that I announce the first fatality at our institution. **Mrs O V N Pule from Nursing Department, Health Sciences Faculty** was admitted at Frere Hospital on Monday 13 July after being diagnosed with Covid-19. Sadly, she succumbed three days later, on 16 July. Her funeral will be held tomorrow, 21 July 2020. May her soul rest in peace

NEW INFECTION: Alice campus

Another employee has tested positive for Covid-19. The colleague is attached to the **Department of Biochemistry** and **Microbiology in the Faculty of Science and Agriculture**, Alice Campus.

NO LOCAL TRANSMISSIONS TO DATE:

As much as Covid-19 infection numbers among UFH people are on the rise, it is important to note that none were transmitted on campus. We will inform the community should such happen. For now though, we really encourage everyone who is aware or suspects that they may be infected, to stay at home, self-isolate and also declare their status by following the normal reporting protocol. It is the responsible thing to do.
