## RETURN OF SENIOR MANAGEMENT AND MANAGEMENT STAFF TO CAMPUS

As part of the process of a phased return to campus, members of the Management Executive Committee (MEC) and the Extended Management Team (EMT), as well as Directors of Centres and Institutes, Deputy Deans, all manager-level staff and Heads of Departments may return to the University from Wednesday, 24 June 2020.

Staff in these categories should apply to the Human Resources Division (<u>Human-Resources@ufh.ac.za</u>) for a permit and have to get in touch with their line managers about specific work arrangements. Staff over the age of 60 and those who have informed the Human Resources Division of existing comorbidities should continue to work remotely.

Our Covid-19 Task Team and the Covid-19 Management Response Committee are continuing with their important work to ensure that all systems and protocols are in place to facilitate the next phase of return of staff and thereafter the 1<sup>st</sup> cohort of students.
